As the year comes to an end we are already busy planning for the coming year. **You can now find the term dates for 2022-2023 on the website**, including the date of our **Winter Concert, Sunday 4 December**. Please save the entire day for this lovely holiday concert. Our first week of classes is September 21.

Other things we would like you to know for next year:

- When planning your next school year please be aware that your class timings may change from year to year. Classes will remain between 3.55-7pm on Wednesdays, please check your email and the website for more information over the summer.
- The **fees for next year will increase to £220/term and £200/ term for siblings. Theory will be £90/term**. The increase in fees will help to cover rising costs at each of our venues as well as other operating costs that have arisen due to the pandemic. These costs, coupled with lower enrolment numbers, has made this increase necessary.
- After many years of concerts at the Amadeus Centre, we have outgrown the space, and so we will be moving our winter concert to the Dyne Auditorium at Highgate School.
- We have begun to offer online information sessions for prospective Lauderdale families. If you know someone who might be interested in joining us please have them contact us for more information about our next meeting, in September.

Theory classes - Is your child aged 7 or older? At this time of year, we would like to invite children aged 7 or older in September to join our theory classes, taught by Clare Clements and Johanna Byrne. Clare and Johanna have many years of experience teaching children theory and preparing them for theory exams and we highly recommend any child who may eventually want to do a grade exam enrol in theory around age 7.

It takes about one year to pass each grade, and in order to take the practical ABRSM exam in Grade 6 and above you must have previously passed Grade 5 Theory. A foundation in the earlier grades is necessary to progress to Grade 5.

Theory classes are held at Highgate Society Hall in Highgate Village directly after school at 3.50 and 4.30. If you have more than one child then another parent can help your child in theory come to Lauderdale House safely after class.
